Wheclock Rachel S. Know all men by these presents, that I, Rachel S. Wheclock, of Mendon, County of Worcester, and State of Massachusetts, in consideration to Edward C. Kinsley of Twenty five dollars to me paid by Edward C. Kinsley, of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Edward C. Kinsley, his heirs and assigns, - A right of way over the extreme westerly part of grantor's premises upon the southerly side of Church street in the Center Village of said Mendon, to drive over the same with teams in common with others. Said right of way shall be limited to a strip of land ten feet wide, and adjacent to the premises of the grantee, and shall not extend further south than the barn of the grantor.

To Have and to hold the granted right, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Edward C. Kinsley, and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever. And I hereby for myself, and my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the said right of way as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs, executors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
