and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever. And I
hereby, for myself and my heirs, executors and adminis-
trators covenant with the grantee and his heirs and
assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the
granted premises, that they are free from all incum-
brance, that I have good right to sell and convey the
same as aforesaid; and that I will, and my heirs, execu-
tors, and administrators shall warrant and defend the
same to the grantee and his heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
And for the consideration aforesaid, I, Thankful S. Taft
the widow of Amariah A. Taft and Ida T. Taft, wife of
the grantor, hereby release unto the grantee and his
heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and home-
stead in the granted premises.
