

Southerly by land now or formerly of the heirs of Alan-
son & Freeman; Easterly by land now or formerly of
the heirs of said Freeman and land now or formerly
of Michael Bassey; and northerly by land of said Michael
Bassey. The second of said tracts is a piece of swamp
land bounded as follows; northerly by land of the heirs
of Christopher Daniels, now or formerly, and land
now or formerly of the heirs of Verville Taft; Easterly
by land now or formerly of the heirs of Elizabeth
Taft, and land now or formerly of the heirs of the said
Verville Taft; Southerly by land now or formerly of El-
lis and George Taft; and Westerly by land now or
formerly of Samuel H. Taft. Containing five acres more
or less. Being the same premises conveyed to me by
Henry W. Gaskill by a mortgagee deed of even date
herewith.

To have and to hold the granted
premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances
thereto belonging, to the said Henry W. Gaskill and his
heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof for-
ever. And I do hereby for myself and my heirs, ex-
ecutors and administrators, covenant with the said
grantee and his heirs and assigns that the granted
premises are free from all incumbrance made or
suffered by me and that I will and my heirs, execu-
tors, and administrators shall, warrant and defend
the same to the said grantee and his heirs and as-
signs forever against the lawful claims and demands
of all persons claiming by, through, or under me but
against none other. And for the consideration afore-
said I, Ida F. Taft, wife of the grantor, do hereby release
unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns all
right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted
premises.
