Bates, of Milford in Book 1629, in the Commonwealth aforesaid, the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Clifton E. Bates, A certain tract of land with a cottage thereon, situated in Mendon in said Commonwealth, on the Northerly side of the road leading from Mendon to Uxbridge, bounded Easterly by a stone wall at land of Nathan G. Daniels; Northethly by a stone wall at land of said Daniels; Westerly by road leading from Mendon and Uxbridge road by the house of B. Frank Aldrich and Southerly by said Mendon and Uxbridge road.

Also another tract of land situated in said Mendon, on the Northerly side of said Mendon and Uxbridge road, bounded Easterly by the road leading by the house of said Aldrich; Northethly by a wall on land of one Aldrich; Westerly by a wall on land of said Aldrich; and Southerly by said Mendon and Uxbridge road. With a right to take water from well opposite said cottage, the same as was conveyed by Elizabeth O. Wood by deed dated Oct. 19, 1894. Being a portion of the premises conveyed by John C.
