Know all men by these presents that we, Sarah J. Dudley, Abbie F. Darling, wife of Albert W. Darling, in her own right, and Joseph H. Dudley, all of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of Thirty-nine Hundred Dollars paid by George M. Taft of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George M. Taft, a certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon situated in Mendon aforesaid and bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a point in the Easterly line of the Providence and Worcester road, so called, and in the South-erly line of the road leading to Milford Mass thence by and with said Milford Road to a corner at land of Edward Dudley; thence turning and running Southerly as the wall now stands and bounding Easterly on said Edward Dudley land to a corner at land formerly of Benjamin D.
