

Thence on said Southwick land, N. 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W., eleven (11) rods and fifteen (15) links to stones at land now or formerly of Samuel Bassett;-

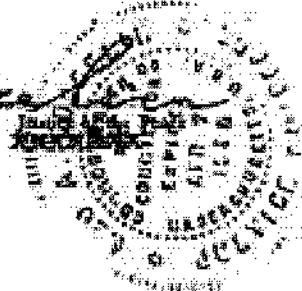
