

7 rods with a wall to a corner of walls at land of Amoret B. Wise; thence with a wall and said last named land N.78°W. 35 rods to land of Nathan M. Daniels et als; thence by said last named land S. 20° 30' W. 25.3 rods to a stake in the wall at other land of the grantor; thence by last named land S. 61°30' E. 16 rods to a corner of walls; thence South 35° West, 2.6 rods, to an angle in the wall; thence S. 22°30' W., 21.6 rods to the first mentioned road; thence easterly on said road 25.4 rods to the place of beginning.";

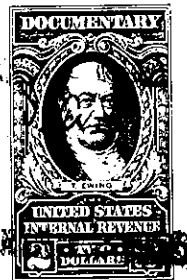
"The second of said tracts is a piece of swamp land bounded as follows:
