Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts Esquire
in consideration of the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars paid me by
Peter Thompson of said Mendon & further in the receipt whereof I do hereby give
knowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Peter Thompson
his heirs and assigns two several pieces of land lying in Mendon aforesaid first
piece containing about twenty acres bounded as follows (viz) beginning at the southwest corner of William Torrey Bullard lot (so
called) on the easterly side of the County road leading to Worcester then running north
easterly by said Torrey's land about one hundred and forty eight rods to a heap of stones
on the westerly side of Muddy brook (so called) thence north 20 E. 3 rods & 2 1/2 links
to a stake and stones at the south east corner of said Wm. Torrey's land thence N. 33
W. 23 rods to Alexander Thayer's land bounding southerly and westerly on said Torrey's
land thence N. 38. E. 5 1/2 rods to a stake and stones thence N. 39 W. 6 rods to a stake &
stones at the southwest corner of lands belonging to Seth Davenport Jr. the two
last mentioned lines bounded on said Alexander Thayer's lands thence N. 31 1/2 E.
41 1/2 rods thence N. 63 E. 34 rods to a stake and stones the two last lines bound
ing northwesterly on said Davenport's lands thence S. 1/2 point E. 64 1/2 rods
to a stake and stones and a log of rocks thence S. 36 1/2 W. 43 rods to a stake and stones
on the easterly side of Muddy brook bounding northwesterly on Stephen
Torrey's land thence down stream said brook by said Stephen Torrey's land
to the southeast corner of the Dorr farm (so called) thence turning and running
southerly by said Torrey's land to the County road aforesaid thence northwesterly
by said road to the first bound. mentioned together with all the buildings then
on standing & The second piece lying on the southerly side of said road
