Know all men by these presents that I Amosiah Harris of Sterling in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts, yeoman, in consideration of love and affection and twenty dollars paid by Alfred Harris Junior of said Sterling, yeoman, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Alfred Harris his heirs and assigns one undivided half of my home farm in said Sterling, containing about eighty acres — Also one undivided half of my meadow lot situate on the easterly side of Stit-River in said Sterling southerly of the bridge over said river on the course of travel from Lancaster to Princeton — And also one undivided half of my pasture situate in Holden in said County containing about twenty seven acres — Also one undivided half of the following creatures to wit, one pair of oxen, four cows, one two-year old heifer, two yearling heifers and ten sheep — To have and to hold the aforegranted premises to the said, . . . his heirs and assigns to his & their use and behoof forever — And I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Alfred his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises that they are free of all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Alfred, and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Alfred his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons — In witness whereof I the said Amosiah Harris have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine —

Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Davenport of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, yeoman, in consideration of nine hundred & fifty dollars paid me by Tralman Green of said Mendon in the County and Commonwealth aforesaid, yeoman, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the said Tralman Green his heirs and assigns two several pieces of land lying in Mendon aforesaid — The first piece lying on the southwesterly side of the road leading from Providence to Worcester containing about ten acres more or less and is bounded as follows beginning at the easterly corner of Levens Gaskills land at a heap of stones thence running southwesterly
