 Gentleman - In consideration of three hundred seventy dollars & fifty cents  
 paid by Daniel Hewitt of Ward in County aforesaid yeoman the receipt  
 whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant, sell and convey  
 unto the said Daniel Hewitt his heirs and assigns a lot of land  
 situate partly in Oxford and Ward containing nineteen & half acres  
 bounded as follows (viz) beginning at the road a corner of Daniel  
 Hewitt's land thence North 58. 15 East 67 1/2 rods to stake & stone cor-  
 ner of W Benja<sup>a</sup> Barris land thence South 38 East 24 rods to stake &  
 stones on said Barris thence South 15 West 33 1/2 rods to stake & stones  
 thence South 65 40 West 35 rods thence South 87. 30 West 30 rods nine  
 links to stake & stones at the road bounded on land sold to Jonas  
 Stackwell thence North 1. 30 West 33 rods to first mentioned bounds

To have and to hold the aforesaid premises to the  
 said Daniel Hewitt his heirs and assigns to his & their use and behoof  
 forever And I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators cov-  
 nant with the said Daniel Hewitt his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully  
 seized in fee of the aforesaid premises that they are free of all incum-  
 brances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the  
 said Daniel Hewitt and that I will warrant and defend the same  
 premises to the said Daniel Hewitt his heirs and assigns forever  
 against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
