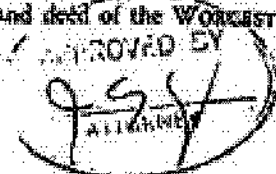

I, William H. Casco,

of Milford, Worcester County, Massachusetts,

being unmarried, for consideration paid, grant to Curtis A. Palmer and Christina P. Palmer,  
husband and wife, as tenants by the entirety, both of Mendon, in said County,

with quitclaim covenants

A certain parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, situated on the  
westerly side of North Avenue, in said Mendon, bounded and described as follows,  
to wit:-

Beginning at a stone bound at land now or formerly of one Oppewall,  
formerly of one Curtin, on the westerly side of said street, thence S. 18° E. by  
the westerly side of said North Avenue about 80 feet to a stake; thence S. 72° W.  
in a straight line from said stake about 241 feet to a wire fence as it now stands  
at land of the Inhabitants of the Town of Mendon; thence N. 17° 45' W. by said  
wire fence about 80 feet to a stake; and thence N. 72° E. in part by said Oppewall
