Venture shall by that be rendered void and of no effect -
To hold for the term of her natural life; or with the above
provisions from the twenty eighth day of May, year aforesaid
yielding and paying therefore the rent of five dollars a year
and the said lessee does promise to pay the said rent in gold
or silver coin in yearly payments and to quit and deliver
up the premises to the lessors or their attorney, peaceably and
quietly, at the end of the term, in as good order and condition
reasonable use and wearing thereof, fire, and other unavoi-
dable casualties excepted, as the same now are, or may be put
into, by the ^{said} lessors, and to pay the rent as above stated, and all
taxes and duties levied, or to be levied thereon, during the term
and for such further time as the lessee may hold the same,
and not make or suffer any waste thereof; nor lease, nor
underlet except the small tenement now let by her, nor per-
mit any other person or persons to occupy or improve the same
or make or suffer to be made, any alteration therein, but with
the approbation of the lessors thereto in writing having been
first obtained; and that the lessors may enter to view, and
make improvements, and to expel the lessee, if she shall
fail to pay the rent and taxes as aforesaid, or make or suffer
any strip or waste thereof. —
