Alderman and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Jepc F. Alderman his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness whereof I the said Benjamin Davenport and Sally Davenport wife of said Benjamin Davenport in token of relinquishment of her right of dower in said estate have hereunto set our hands and seals this first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three.
