 comes to Muddy Brook, thence Northwesterly up said
 stream untill it comes to the Northwest corner of Seth
 Hastings Esq. dec^d land and is bounded by said Hastings
 land thence Northeasterly to the eight rod road so called
 to a heap of stones and is bounded Southeasterly by
 said Hastings land, thence Northwesterly to William
 Torrey's dec^d land to a heap of stones, and is bounded
 Northeasterly by said eight rod road thence Southwesterly
 untill it comes to land owned formerly by Enos Taft
 the Westerly side of said Worcester road at a heap of
 stones, and is bounded Northwesterly by said Torrey's
 land thence Southeasterly till it comes to the Southeast
 corner of Enos Taft's land owned by him formerly and
 is bounded Southwesterly by said Enos Taft's land,
 thence Southeasterly by land now owned by Aaron C.
 Cook till it comes to the extreme Southwest corner of the
