of Milford in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of
William S. Hastings of Massachusetts in consideration of two thousand dollars
paid by William Goden Hastings of Mendon in said County &
Commonwealth the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do
hereby give grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
William Goden Hastings his heirs and assigns A certain tract
of land situated upon the Westerly side of the road leading
from Mendon to Worcester with all the buildings thereon and
bounded as follows viz: Beginning at a stake and stones at
grantors other land thence Southerly by and with the road
aforesaid eleven rods and fourteen links to land of A. H. Reed
thence turning and running Westerly as the fence and wall
now stand bounded Southerly by land of said Reed to a corner
at land of Aaron C. Cook thence turning and running Northerly as
the wall and fence now stand bounded Westerly on land of
said Cook eleven rods and fourteen links to a stake and stone
beside the fence at grantors other land thence turning and
running Easterly in a straight line to the first mentioned bound
at the place of beginning. To have and to hold the
above granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances
thereto belonging to the said William Goden Hastings his heirs
and assigns To his and their use and behoof forever. And I
the said Amariah A. Taft for myself and my heirs executors
and administrators do covenant with the said William Goden Hastings
his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee sim-
ple of the aforesigned premises that they are free from all incum-
brances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to
the said William Goden Hastings his heirs and assigns forever
as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs executors and
administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said
William Goden Hastings his heirs and assigns forever against the
lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness
