Know all men by these presents that I, Amariah A. Taft
 of Milford in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of
 Massachusetts, in consideration of twenty five hundred dollars
 paid by Eli Bates of Mendon in said County, the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and
 convey unto the said Eli Bates, his heirs and assigns, a certain
 parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situated on the
 Westerly side of the road leading from said Mendon to Upton
 bounded as follows, to wit: on the East by said road; on the
 North by land now or formerly of the heirs of Joseph Albee; on
 the West by land of Michael Foley and the road called
 Washington street; on the South by land of David W. Bennett
 and land of Eunice Briggs, containing sixty acres, be the
 same more or less. Reserving from said lot the road lead-
 ing from Mendon to Northbridge part the house on said prem-
 ises, it being a town way; known as the Otis Thayer place.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all
 the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said
 Eli Bates and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and
 behoof forever. And I do hereby for myself and my heirs,
 executors and administrators, covenant with the said grantee
