Know all men by these presents that we, Rupert F.
 Bates and Frank E. Stevens both of Mendon County of Worcester
 and Commonwealth of Massachusetts and Agnes E. Bates of Milford
 in said County, in consideration of Two Hundred Dollars paid by
 Edwin A. Bates of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged, do hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said
 Edwin A. Bates a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the
 Easterly part of Upton in said County on the Westerly side of the
 road leading from the house now or formerly of Charles Dow part what
 has been known as the District No 3 School house in Upton and the
 residence of Adams Rockwood to Hopkinton. Said tract is woodland
 and open land, contains twenty-two acres more or less and is the
 same premises conveyed to Eli Bates by two deeds from Whitman Hol-
 brook the first dated February 27th A.D. 1884 recorded with Worcester Dis-
 trict Deeds Book 1166 Page 214, the second dated June 24 A.D. 1884
 and recorded with said Deeds Book 1175 Page 420. Grantors being
 heirs of said Eli Bates except said Stevens whose title to the gran-
 ted premises is derived by deed recently recorded from John L.
 Bates another heir of said Eli Bates.

To have and
 to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appur-
 tenances thereto belonging, to the said Edwin A. Bates and his heirs
 and assigns to their use and behoof forever. And we do here-
 by for ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators cov-
 ernt with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that the gran-
 ted premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by
 us, and that we will and our heirs, executors and administra-
 tors shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and
 his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands
 of all persons claiming by, through, or under us but against none
 other. And for the consideration aforesaid, Margaret A. Bates wife
 of the said Rupert F. Bates and Maida A. Stevens wife of the
 said Frank E. Stevens do hereby release unto the said grantee and
 his heirs and assigns all right of us to both dower and homestead
