Spofford of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of One dollar & other valuable considerations paid by Henry W. Gaskill of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Henry W. Gaskill, a certain farm situated in said Mendon on the Westerly side of the road leading from said Mendon to Upton, being the same premises described in a deed from Amariah A. Taft to Eli Bates dated June 6th 1881, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds, Book 1095, Page 266, also in a deed from said Taft to said Bates dated May 30th 1881, recorded with said deeds, Book 1117, Page 601, to which deeds and records reference may be had for a more particular description of said premises.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Henry W. Gaskill and his heirs and assigns, to their own use and behoof forever. And I do hereby for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators covenant with the said grantee and his heirs and assigns that the granted premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me, except a mortgage for \$2000 and interest and all unpaid taxes and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through or under me except as above, but against none other.
