Taber of \$1950. less the payments made thereon. Said mortgages being on the whole premises herein described, that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, except as aforesaid. And for the consideration aforesaid I, Jeannette E. Bagley, wife of Herbert P. Bagley, do hereby release unto the said grantee and his heirs and assigns all right of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises.
