That THE PARKER OIL COMBING COMPANY, LIMITED, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and having its usual place of business in Barre, Worcester County, Massachusetts (hereinafter called the Grantor), for consideration paid, grants to the GARDNER ELECTRIC LIGHT COMPANY, a Massachusetts corporation having its usual place of business in Gardner, Worcester County, Massachusetts (hereinafter called the Grantee), with warranty covenants, the right and easement to construct, reconstruct, repair, maintain, operate and patrol, for the transmission of high and low voltage electric current and for telephone use, lines of poles (which may be erected at different times), with wires and cables strung and street
