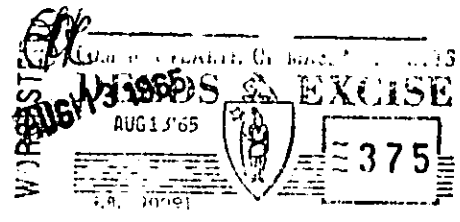


WE, GEORGE C. ROBINSON and BERTHA ROBINSON, husband and wife, both
