KNOW ALL MEN by these Presents that I Henry Penniman
of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massa-
chusetts Yeoman in consideration of the just sum of thirteen hundred
Pounds Lawfull Silver Money to me in hand before the Delivery
whereof paid by Seth Davenport of Mendon in the same County
& Commonwealth Yeoman the Receipt whereof I do hereby
Acknowledege have given granted, bargained & sold, & do by these
Presente give, grant, bargain, sell, alene, & fully freely & absolutely
convey & confirm unto him the said Seth Davenport his Heirs &
Assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being in
the Townships of Mendon aforesaid containing by estimation one
hundred & thirty eight Acres be the same more or less bounded as
followeth; Beginning at a heap of Stones by the County Road
being the South west corner of the Grantees land & thence running
Southeasterly & bounding westerly by said County to a heap of Stones
at the north west corner of Mr Alexander Thayers Land, then running
Easterly & bounding southerly by said Thayers Land to a white oak
tree on the left side of muddy brook it being said Thayer's north-
east corner, then turning & running southerly by said Thayers
Land to a heap of Stones by land of Stephen Torrey, then turning
& running easterly by said Torreys Land to a heap of Stones by the
light Rod road (so called) being the Southeast corner, then turning
& running Northerly & bounded easterly by said eight Rod road
to land of the Grantee and thence running westerly by land of the
Grantee to the first mentioned bounds including all the land
which the Grantor purchased of George Bruce Jun: Benj: Green
& Josiah Adams Preterne being had to the said Deeds of conveyance
together with all the Buildings & Edifices thereon erected —

I O HAVE & TO HOLD the said granted & bargained Premises
together with all their appurtenances free of all Incumbrances
whatever to him the said Seth Davenport his Heir & Assign
as an absolute Estate of inheritance in fee simple forever, and
I the said Henry Penniman for myself my Heirs, Executors and
Administrators do covenant & engage the above demised Premises
to him the said Seth Davenport his Heir & Assign against the
lawfull claims & demands of any Person or Persons whatsoever
forever hereafter to warrant, secure & defend by these Presents
