To the Sheriffs of our Counties of Middlesex & Worcester or their Deputies Greeting

Know all Men that John G. Thayer in said County of Middlesex

Whereas John Fisher of Middlesex Housewright by the consideration of our Justices of our Court of Common Pleas holden at Concord for and within our County of Middlesex aforesaid on the Monday next preceding the second Tuesday of September instant received judgment against John G. Thayer of Holliston in said County of Middlesex for the sum of one hundred and twelve dollars and eighty eight cents damage & fifteen dollars and ninety six cents costs of suit as to us appears of record whereof execution remains to be done we command you therefore that of the good chattels or lands of the said Thayer within your precinct you cause to be paid and satisfied unto the said Fisher at the value thereof in money the aforesaid sum being one hundred twenty eight dollars & eighty five cents in the whole with twenty five cents more for this Writ and thereof also to satisfy yourself for your own fees and for want of good chattels or lands of said Thayer to be by him shown unto you or found within your precinct to the acceptance of the said Fisher to satisfy the sum aforesaid we command you to take the body of the said Thayer and him commit unto our Gaol in Cambridge Concord or Worcester in our County of Middlesex or Worcester aforesaid and detain in your custody within our said Gaol until he pay the full sum above mentioned with your fees or that he be discharged by the said Fisher the Creditor or otherwise by order of law hereof fail not and make return of this writ with your doings therein into our said Court of Common Pleas to be holden at Cambridge within our County of Middlesex aforesaid upon the Monday next preceding the third Tuesday of December next witness James Prescott Esq. at Cambridge the twenty sixth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight. Middlesex Octr 10th 1808 Ephraim Littlefield James Wright & Ebenezer Cutler all being sufficient freeholders within said County were sworn faithfully and impartially according to their best skill & judgment to appraise such Real Estate as shall be shown to them towards satisfying the within Execution & intervening charge before me - James Mellen Jus. of Peace

Worcester Octobr 10th 1808 then personally appeared William Torrey Seth Davenport Jr & Grindall Wood all freeholders within said County and made oath that they would faithfully and impartially appraise such real estate as may be shown unto them towards satisfying the within Execution before me - Joseph Adams Justice Peace

Worcester Octobr 14th 1808 We the above named William Torrey Seth Davenport Jr & Grindall Wood having been sworn as above mentioned have appraised and do hereby appraise all the right interest and estate which the within named John G. Thayer late of Holliston did seized and possess: excepting his right in the building thereon standing (viz) the dwelling
