To the Sheriff of our County of Worcester or his Deputy Greeting

Whereas Asa Child of Wotton in our County of Worcester Esquire by the consideration of our Justices of our Court of Common Pleas holden at Worcester within and for our County of Worcester aforesaid on the Monday next preceding the second Tuesday of June last recovered Judgment against Nathaniel Nelson of Milford in our County aforesaid His landman alias Labourer for the sum of one hundred and fifty seven dollars and ninety two cents damage and eleven dollars & thirty two cents costs of suit and whereas by the consideration of the same Court Execution was likewise awarded for the same sums against the goods effects and credits of the said Nathaniel in the hands & possession of Ezra Nelson of Milford aforesaid Esquire Trustee of the said Nathaniel as to us appears of Record whereof Execution remains to be done we command you therefore that of the goods chattels or lands of the said Nathaniel in his own hands and possession and of the goods effects and credits of the said Nathaniel in the hands and possession of the said Ezra jointly and severally you cause to be paid and satisfied unto the said Asa at the value thereof in money the aforesaid sums being one hundred and sixty nine dollars & twenty four cents in the whole with twenty five cents more for this writ and thereof also to satisfy yourself for your own fees and for want of goods chattels or lands of the said Nathaniel in his own right hands and possession to be by him shown unto you or found in your printed to the satisfaction of the said Asa, and for want of goods effects and credits of the said Nathaniel in the hands and possession of the said Trustee to be by him discovered and exposed to you to satisfy the several sums aforesaid with your own fees we command you that you take the body of the said Nathaniel and him commit to our Gaol in Worcester in our County of Worcester aforesaid and detain in your custody within our said Gaol until he pay the full sums aforesaid mentioned with your fees or that he be discharged by the said
