and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or appertaining, it
being all that tract of land, which I now occupy and improve
as my homestead farm. — To have and to hold the aforesigned
premises to the said Benjamin Peirce his heirs and assigns, to his
and their use and behoof forever, and I do covenant with the
said Benjamin Peirce his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully
seized in fee of the aforesigned premises; that they are free of
all encumbrances; that I have good right to sell and convey the
same to the said Benjamin Peirce and that I will warrant and
defend the same premises to the said Benjamin Peirce his
heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and
demands of all persons. Provided nevertheless, that if the said
John Fisher his heirs, Executors, or administrators, pay to the
said Benjamin Peirce his heirs, Executors, administrators or
assigns, the sum of One thousand dollars with lawful inte-
rest on or before the third day of October next then this
deed, as also a certain promissory note bearing even date
with these presents, given by the said John Fisher to the said
Benjamin Peirce to pay the same sum with interest at the
time aforesaid, shall both be void; otherwise shall remain
in full force. In witness whereof, I the said John Fisher, and
Elizabeth wife of the said John in testimony of her voluntary
relinquishment of her right of dower in the before granted and
described premises have hereunto set our hands and seals this
third day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and twenty two. —
