Know all men by these presents that I Elias Wood of Mendon  
County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts in con-  
sideration of sixteen hundred dollars to me paid by Joseph Albee  
of Milford County of Worcester and State aforesaid the receipt  
whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and  
convey unto the said Joseph Albee his heirs and assigns a certain  
tract of land situated in the Northerly part of Mendon afore-  
said with the buildings thereon and bounded as follows to wit:  
Beginning at Northwesterly corner of said premises on the road  
leading from Providence to Worcester and running Easterly and  
bounding Northerly on lands of Calvin Turner Ezra Morrey  
and Joseph G. Davenport thence running Southerly and bounding  
Easterly on said Davenports land to land of George Staples, thence  
running Westerly and bounded Southerly on land of George  
Staples to the road aforesaid thence running Northerly and bound-  
ed by said road to the first mentioned bound containing twenty and  
one third acres more or less. Being the same and all that is  
described in two deeds, one from Luther H. Fisher to Elias Wood  
recorded in the Worcester County Registry of Deeds Book 348 Page  
160. the other deed from Perry Daniels to Elias Wood recorded at the
