Davenport, Easterly as the wall now stands to a corner of land of Joseph Albee, thence turning and running Westerly and bounded Southerly by land of said Albee and ofabella Turner as the wall now stands to a corner at the road aforesaid, thence turning and running Northerly by and with said road to the bound first mentioned at the place of beginning: meaning hereby to convey the same premises conveyed to me by deed dated June 2nd A.D. 1869 from Harriet Doggett and Samuel W.
