Davenport Charlotte A. Know all men by these presents, that I, Charlotte A. Davenport of Mendon, State of Massachusetts, in consider-
ation of seven hundred & fifty dollars paid by John L. Davenport of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
the said John L. Davenport, his heirs & assigns, a certain tract
of land with the buildings thereon, situated in said Mendon
on the Easterly side of the road leading from Mendon to the
City of Worcester, and bounded as follows, (viz.) Beginning at
the Northwesterly corner of said tract on the road aforesaid,
thence Easterly & bounded Northerly by Charles A. Davenport
as the fence now stands to a corner, thence turning and run-
ning Southerly & bounded Easterly on land of Charles A. Dav-
enport as the wall now stands to a corner at land of Joseph
Albee, thence turning & running Westerly & bounded Southerly
by lands of Joseph Albee & Isabella Turner as the wall now
stands to a corner at the road aforesaid; thence turning &
running Northerly by and with said road to the place of be-
ginning. It being the same & all the same premises conveyed to
me by deed of James Quigley dated Mar. 4th A.D. 1871 recorded
with Worcester County Deeds, Book 834 Page 318. This conveyance
is made subject to three mortgages on which there is about
\$500 due. To have and to hold, the granted
premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belong-
ing, to the said John L. Davenport and his heirs and assigns.
