I now acknowledge these presents that I Joseph Tommy of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts Gentleman in consideration of Three Thousand Dollars paid by Seth Davenport of said Mendon to me the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grants sell and convey unto the said Seth Davenport his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land with all the buildings standing and being thereon situated and lying in Mendon aforesaid containing Eighty acres be the same more or less butted and bounded as follows vizt Beginning at the Southeastly corner of the premises at the west end of William Torrey's stone wall then running Easterly and bounding Southerly on said William Torrey's land then crooping the County road near the said William Torrey's dwelling house and then still running Easterly and bounding Southerly upon land belonging to the said William Torrey to muddy brook then running Northwesterly and bounding Southeasterly (crooping a road) on said William Torrey's land to a heap of stones thirty two rod from the corner of Henry Swett's land to a heap of stones at the eight rod road (so called) thence running Northerly and bounding Easterly on said road forty rod then running Southwesterly & bounding Northwesterly on Joseph Rawson's land to a heap of stones on a ledge of rocks by the side of a maple stump at the corner of Peter Thompson's land still running Southwesterly & bounding Northwesterly on said Peter Thompson's land to muddy brook then running Southwesterly and bounding Northerly on said Thompson's land thence running Northerly & bounding Northwesterly on said Thompson's land to to the County road crooping the said road and running the same course on the s<sup>d</sup> Thompson's land to the corner of said Thompson's land then running Southwesterly & bounding Southwesterly on Enos Taft's land to the first mentioned bounds —
