I know all men by these presents, that I Joseph Cummings of Upton in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of Six hundred Dollars paid by Obediah Baker of Upton in said County and Commonwealth, Boot Maker, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, Sell, and convey, unto the said Obediah Baker, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract of land with the buildings thereon, and all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging, Situated in Mendon in said County and bounded as follows Beginning at the Southeasterly corner on the Westerly side of the Providence and Worcester road and running with the road Northerly four rods twelve and three fourths links to Stake and Stones, thence South 73° West ten rods twenty two links to a Stake and Stones at the Northwesterly corner, thence South 14° East five rods and five links to a Stake and Stones by the wall, thence Easterly about eleven rods to the first mentioned bound.

To have and to hold the afore-granted premises, to the said Obediah Baker, his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do for myself my heirs, executors and administrators covenant with the said Obediah Baker, his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully Seised in fee of the afore-granted premises, that they are free of all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Obediah Baker, and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Obediah Baker, his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

In witness whereof I the said Joseph Cummings together with Celista Cummings, wife of the said Joseph, in token of relinquishing her right of dower in said premises, have hereunto set our hands and seals, this 28th Day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty.
