Davenport of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Yeoman in consideration of twenty six dollars and forty cents paid by Isabella Turner wife of Calvin Turner of said Mendon in said County Bootmaker the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do give grant sell and convey unto the said Isabella Turner her heirs and assigns the following described pieces of land situated in said Mendon and bounded as follows to wit beginning at the Northcasterly corner of land belonging to the said Isabella thence running Easterly bounding Northerly by land of the grantor seventeen rods 8 links to a stake and stones by the wall at land of Elias Wood thence turning Southwesterly bounding Southeasterly by land of said Wood as the wall now stands nineteen rods 7 links to a corner at land of the grantee thence turning Northerly and bounding Westerly by land of the grantee nine rods and 17 links to the point of beginning containing eighty four rods and a half. It is also agreed that the said Isabella her heirs or assigns are to build and forever maintain
