 now Twenty four rods and 5 links to a corner at land
 of Elias Wood thence turning Southwesterly by land
 of said Wood bounding Southerly by land of said Wood
 Twenty seven rods 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ links to the said road, thence running
 Northerly bounding Westerly by said road Thirteen rods 15
 links to the point of beginning containing One acre and
 four rods more or less.
