 edge) do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey
 unto the said Charles Wood, Joseph T. Light, Washing-
 ton J. Fisher their heirs and assigns forever, a certain
 lot of land in the City of Worcester containing twelve thou-
 sand square feet and is bounded and described as fol-
 lows - Beginning at the Northeast corner of said lot a cor-
 ner of Beacon & Sagrange Streets, thence running westerly
 on Sagrange Street One hundred & twenty feet to land now
 or late of James Estabrook, thence southerly by said Esta-
 brook land one hundred feet to a stake, thence running
 Easterly one hundred & twenty feet to said Beacon Street
 thence running northerly on said Beacon street one hun-
 dred feet to the place of Beginning.
