One-thousand and eight-hundred dollars, paid by Horace Warner, of said West-Bowlington, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey, unto the said Horace Warner, his heirs and assigns, a certain piece or parcel of land lying in the central part of said West-Bowlington, containing eight thousand and sixteen square feet be the same more or less, bounded as follows - to wit - Beginning on the line of a County-Road leading from the Beaman Bridge, so called, to the Centre School-House, at a stake, and running thence north, 19° west, eighty feet by a street to a stake - thence south, 70° west, one-hundred and eight feet by land now or late of Elias Davis, to a stake - thence south, 21° 30' east, eighty feet by a public street to a stake on the line of said County-Road - thence northeasterly, by said County-Road one-hundred and six feet, to the place of beginning.

To have and to hold the afore-granted premises, to the said Horace Warner, his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant with the said Horace Warner his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the afore-granted premises: that they are free of all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Warner, and that I will and my heirs shall warrant and defend the same premises to the said Horace Warner, his heirs, and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
