Know all men by these presents that I Rufus Harris of Mendon
 in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts
 in consideration of five hundred and twenty five dollars to me
 paid by Liberty Goss of said Mendon, the receipt whereof I do
 hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto
 the said Liberty Goss his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land
 situate in Upton, in said County on the Southwesterly side of
 the road leading from Mendon to Upton over Miscoe Hill, con-
 taining 2 1/4 acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit:
 commencing on said road at the end of a wall being the South-
 easterly corner of the premises and a corner of the land of
 Thomas Cary thence running North 18 1/2° West by said road
 9 rods + 10 links, thence North 28 1/2° West 5 7/8 rods by said road
 to a stake and stones, thence Westerly + 3 1/2 rods to a stake, thence
 South 64 1/2° West 32 rods by grantors other land to a stake, thence
 South 71° West 4 rods to a stake, thence South 6° West 11 rods and
 5 links to a stake thence South 38 1/2° West 7 rods + 7 links to the
 end of a wall the three last lines bounding by grantors other land
 thence by said wall bounding on said Carys land South 88 1/4°
 East 96 rods to the place of beginning.

I do have and
 to hold the aforegranted premises to the said Liberty Goss his heirs
 and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever And I do for
 myself, my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the
 the said Goss his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in
 fee of the aforegranted premises that they are free of all in-
 cumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same
 to the said Goss and that I will warrant and defend the same
 premises to the said Goss his heirs and assigns forever against
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons

 Harris, in token of her release of all right of dower in the premises have
 hereunto set our hands and seals, this thirtieth day of April in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six -
