Davenport deceased did inherit and possessed of, and which has come to me as heir at law of my late daughter Ellen Fisher Davenport declared. To have and to hold the same to the said Mary H. Davenport her heirs and assigns, to her and their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant to warrant and defend said granted and quitclaimed premises to the said Mary H.
