Know all men by, these presents that I, Thomas J. Neugent of Milford in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, being unmarried, in consideration of eight hundred dollars paid by Melcombe Staples of Mendon in the County of Worcester aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Staples, the farm, this day deeded to me by said Staples situate in said Mendon, on both sides of the road leading past the dwelling house of Francis C. Fletcher and bounded as follows. The part of said farm on the easterly side of said road is bounded southerly by land of Chapman Aldrich, easterly by land of H. M. Goff, land of Stephen Honey and land of D. W. Bennett, north-easterly by land of said Bennett and land of H. C. Cook and westerly by said road. The part of said farm westerly of said road is bounded southerly by land of Henry Rawson and land of H. C. & J. M. Staples. Easterly by said road. North-easterly by land of Stephen Cook and westerly by land of Charles Fletcher.

To have and to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Melcombe Staples, his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I, the said Thomas J. Neugent for me and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Melcombe Staples, his heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesaid premises, that they are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Staples his heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Staples.
