


Know all men by these presents that I Harriet Davenport of Mendon in the county of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, widow, in consideration of sixteen hundred dollars paid by Joseph Albee of said Mendon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Joseph Albee, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract of land with all the buildings thereon, situated in said Mendon upon the westerly side of the road lead from Mendon to Worcester and bounded as follows viz: Beginning at a point on the westerly side of said road at land of Peter Wood; thence northerly by and with said — until it comes to land of Liberty Goss; thence turning and running westerly as the wall now stands, to a corner, at land of Otis Thayer, bounded northerly by land of said Goss; thence turning and running southerly, as the ditch, fence and wall now stands to a corner; thence turning and running easterly as the wall now stands to a corner at the Locust Hill Cemetery; the last two lines bounded on land of said Otis Thayer, westerly and southerly; thence turning and running northerly as the wall now stands to a corner; thence turning and running easterly as the wall now stands to a corner; the last two lines bounded easterly and southerly by said Cemetery; thence north 8° west thirty one rods and nine links to a stake in the wall bounded easterly by land of Joseph Cummings; thence turning and
