oline Williams of the same place, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
the said Williams, all that certain land situated in said
Southbridge and lying along the line of the location of a new
contemplated street to be built by the said grantor over his land
mainly, formerly owned by Dr. S. C. Hartwell, and upon the
Northerly side of the said location, which line is the Northerly line
of the location of the said new street, and is defined and describ-
ed as follows to wit: Beginning at a stone bound at the N. W.
corner of the "Esther Clarke" lot owned by said grantor; then N.
62° 30' W. 97.7 feet to a stone bound at an angle in said line, and
the grantor hereby conveys all the land lying along the Northerly
side of said line, and between it and the land of the grantee.

To have and to hold the granted premises, with
all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said
Caroline Williams and her heirs and assigns, to their own use and
behoof forever. And I do hereby for myself and my heirs, executors
and administrators covenant with the said grantee and her heirs
