ten dollars out of my estate in one year
after my decease - The said Pincher

one hundred dollars out of my estate in
one year after my decease. Also the said
Pincher Lovett to pay to my daughter
Elizabeth Morse five dollars to be paid out
of my estate in one year after my decease.

The said Pincher Lovett also to pay to my
daughter Rebecca McClintock five dollars
out of my estate within one year after my
decease. Also the said Pincher Lovett to
pay to my daughter Abigail Lovett one
