

Fifthly I intend after my death to pay to my Daughter Hannah Bacon, the use & annual Interest of One hundred and fifty Dollars, the Obligation to be given by my Son Rufus Vintress in one year after my decease and deposited in the hands of my Son Nathaniel before named and the Interest Annually and punctually paid to the said Hannah during her natural life and at her decease the principal shall be paid to such of her Children as shall then be living, if they shall have arrived at lawfull age otherwise to be paid to them respectively as they shall arrive at lawfull age. The aforesaid sum of One hundred & fifty Dollars is also to be taken out of the above mentioned Obligation which I hold against my Son Rufus. And after paying and securing the two sums last before this to my Daughter Martha & Hannah & deducting the same from said Obligation, the residue of said Obligation shall be given up to the aforesaid Rufus without any further payment.

Sixthly I give, bequeath and devise to my six Children vizt Martha Rice, Nathaniel Dodge, Sarah Dodge, Rufus Dodge, Hannah Bacon & Lucy Dodge in equal shares, all that part of my Real Estate which I have in this Will assigned to my Wife, as her Dower to be distributed among them at her decease, and to hold the same to them, their heirs and assigns forever.

Seventhly I give my Wearing Apparel to my two Sons Nathaniel and Rufus to be divided equally between them.

Eighthly I give and bequeath to my Son Rufus and my two Daughters Sarah and Lucy, all the residue of my Personal Property not before disposed of in this Will of whatever nature and where ever found to be divided in equal parts between them.

And I name, constitute and appoint my two Sons Nathaniel Dodge and Rufus Dodge joint Executors of this Will, hereby revoking all other and former Wills by me made.

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the twenty ninth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ten.

said Commonwealth, unto Nathⁿ & Rufus Dodge the before named
Executors well and faithfully to execute the said Will, and to ad-
minister the estate of the said Deceased according thereto, who ac-
tivated said trust, and have given Bond to pay the Decreas'd Debts
& Legacies and to render an Account (upon Oaths) of their proceedings
when thereunto lawfully required.

certainty of this transitory life and knowing that it is appointed
unto all men once to die, do make, publish and declare this In-
strument to be my last Will and Testament, in manner and
form following. Wt.

Principally and first of all, I give and command my
Immortal Soul into the hands of God who gave it whenever I shall
be his sovereign Will and pleasure to remove me from this World.
I do it in hopes of his gracious acceptance through the merits of
Christ alone; and my mortal Body I command to the Earth
whence it was taken to be interred in Christian burial at the dis-
cretion
