Stephen Willards yeoman in consideration of three thousand  
eight hundred dollars paid by Stephen Willards  
of said Mendon Gentleman the receipt whereof I do  
hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and  
convey unto the said Stephen Willards his heirs and  
assigns forever a certain tract of land, or farm with all  
the buildings standing thereon, situate in Mendon aforesaid,  
being the farm on which I now live containing  
by estimation one hundred and fifty acres be the  
same more or less, bounded as follows, to wit, beginning  
on the north side of the road which passes through  
said premises at the south west corner of Stephen  
Woods Orchard thence running ~~north~~  $15\frac{1}{3}^{\circ}$  west,  
sixty one rods and one third, thence north  $31^{\circ}$  West  
 $52\frac{1}{2}$  rods to a heap of stones, thence south  $81\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  west 78  
rods and  $\frac{2}{3}$  to a stake and stones bounding easterly on  
lands of Stephen Wood thence south  $19\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  east 68 rods  
to said road, bounding on lands of Eno's Taft, thence
