a certain tract of lands with the buildings thereon
situate in said Worcester, about one mile northerly
of the second Parish Meeting House in said Town,
and near the School House by Capt. John Gleason's,
bounded as follows— viz— "beginning at the southwest
corner of said tract at the intersection of the roads
by the said School House, and bounded southerly
on the road leading from said School House to
Boston, until it comes, to Capt^s Sam^l Brooks's land
thence turning northerly, and running to the North-
-easterly corner of said tract, bounded easterly on
said Brooks's land, thence turning and running
easterly to the road leading by said School House
to Lancaster, bounded northerly by said Brooks's land
thence turning & running southerly & bounded westerly
on the last mentioned road to the first mentioned
corner, — and is the same land and buildings which
descended to us by our Honoured Father, Daniel
Heywood late of said Worcester, dec^d. Excepting & reserving
to our mother, Abigail Heywood the use & improvement
during her life of one third part of said premises, as
