Know all men by these presents, that I, Arnold Paine of Mendon in the County
of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Yeoman — In consideration
of four thousand dollars paid by Thomas Taft of said Mendon County of Wor-
ester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts Yeoman — The receipt whereof I do
hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Thom-
as Taft, his heirs and assigns a certain farm or tract of land situated in said
Mendon and containing one hundred and thirty-five acres being the same more
less with all the buildings thereon and all the privileges and appurtenances
thereunto belonging, it being the whole of the farm and buildings that
said Arnold has lived upon and improved for about two years and a half past and
is the same tract of land that Ned Paine father of said Arnold purchased of Levi
Thawson by deed dated January 14, 1813, and recorded in the Registry of deeds
in the County of Worcester aforesaid; Book 184 and Page p. 25 to which reference
is hereby had for metes and bounds — And also one other piece containing
about one acre adjoining the easterly part of said described premises, it being
land conveyed to said Arnold Paine by Simon Whedon of said Mendon to which
deed reference is hereby had for metes and bounds — To have and to hold
the aforesigned premises to the said Thomas Taft, his heirs and assigns to his
use and the use and behoof forever, and I do for myself my heirs, executors and
administrators, covenant with the said Thomas Taft, his heirs and assigns
that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises, that they are
free of all incumbrances, excepting a mortgage deed upon said premises, dated
July 24, 1838 given to George Willard and Windsor Mowry (the amount of
said mortgage deed up to the date of this deed being a part of the consideration
of this deed) that I have a good right to sell and convey the same to the
said Thomas Taft and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to
the said Thomas Taft, his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims
and demands of all persons excepting said mortgage the said granted pur-
chasor said premises under the incumbrance of said mortgage to pay the
same, it being deducted from the purchase money — In witness whereof
I the said Arnold Paine and I Watty Paine wife of the said Arnold Paine in
testimony of quitting my right of dower or thirds in said premises have here-
unto set our hands and seals this sixth day of September in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight — Arnold Paine (seal)
