 Alexander H. Rugg & Charles H. Rugg both of said Sterling
 the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give
 grant sell and convey unto the said Alexander H. Rugg
 & Chas. H. Rugg their heirs and assigns a certain tract of
 pasture & wood land containing 44 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of land more
 or less laying in the Southwesterly part of Leominster
 in said County & bounded Westerly on Leominster town
 line: Northerly on land of Luther P. Clark: Easterly on
 the highway: Southerly on land of Darwin Powers & for
 a particular description reference may be had to a deed
 of Sam'l Sawyer 2^d to Sylvester Rooper & Silas Rooper Jr
 dated April 18. 1811 & recorded with Worcester Deeds
 Book 181 Page 265.

To have and to hold the
 afore granted premises to the said Alexander H. Rugg &
 Chas. H. Rugg their heirs and assigns to their use and
 behoof forever. And I do for myself my heirs executors
 and administrators covenant with the said Ruggs.
 their heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee
 of the afore granted premises: that they are free of all
 incumbrances: that I have good right to sell and convey
 the same to the said Ruggs and that I will and my heirs
 shall warrant and defend the same premises to the said
 Alexander H. Rugg & Chas. H. Rugg their heirs and assigns
 forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons

 February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and fifty seven. Merrick Rooper. Seal
