

Taft his heirs executors and administrators forever by these presents: have given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, conveyed and confirmed; and by these presents do freely, fully and absolutely give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, convey and confirm unto him the said Newell N. Taft his heirs and assigns forever. All my right title and interest into the homestead estate of my late honored father Warilla Taft, late of Mendon Worcester County, Massachusetts, deceased, situated in said Mendon on both sides of the highway leading from Uxbridge to Albeeville, bounded on the North by land of Alanson Taft and Christopher Daniels and on the South by land of Deborah Staples, and containing by estimation seventy seven acres more or less.
