

Taft wife of said Samuel H. in token of her release of all right and title of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises have hereunto set our hands and seals this eight day of May in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and seventy three.

Beginning at the Northwest corner of grantee's house lot & being on the Town way leading by the dwelling house of grantor
