Taft his heirs and assigns Book 1350, Page 326 the following described tracts of land being in the Westerly part of said Mendon and on both sides of the road leading from Mendon to Northbridge, the first tract with the buildings thereon and situated on the South side of said road and containing six acres, be the same more or less, and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning stake & stones N.
