tion aforesaid, do hereby release and quitclaim unto the
said W^m H. Morse his heirs and assigns, all the right,
title, claim or demand which I may have in and unto
the premises hereby conveyed, under or by virtue of the
homestead exemption laws of the Commonwealth of Massa-
chusetts, and also all right, claim, or possibility of dower
in said premises.
