remit, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Nathan  
G. Daniels, a certain tract of land with buildings thereon situ-  
ated in said Mendon, on the Southerly side of the road lead-  
ing from Albeville in said Mendon to Uxbridge, bounded on  
the North by said road, on the West by land formerly of Chris-  
topher Daniels, on the South by land formerly owned by Benoni  
Staples, on the East by a road leading from said Albeville to  
the Chestnut Hill meeting house, land of one Richardson and  
the school house lot - containing fifty acres more or less. Also one  
other piece of land on the Northerly side of said Uxbridge  
road opposite the house on said premises first named; Boun-  
ded on the South by said road; on the East by land formerly  
of Henry Blanchard, on the North by said Blanchard land,  
land formerly of Hanson Taft and land formerly of Warren
